The Rural Municipality of North Qu'Appelle No. 187

Bylaw No. 04-01

A Bylaw to establish a haying policy pursuant to Section 206(2) of the Rural Municipality Act, 1989.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of North Qu'Appelle No. 187, incorporated in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1. For the purpose of this bylaw the expression:
 - a) "municipality" means the Rural Municipality of North Qu'Appelle No. 187
 - b) "right-of-way" means a "public highway" as defined by the *Rural Municipality Act*, 1989.
- 2. Conditions for the salvage of hay from right-of- ways in the municipality:
 - a) Persons wishing to bale hay along a municipal right-of-way must obtain a permit from the municipality by June 30th of each year.
 - b) Those ditches having permits issued for private use baling will be left uncut until July 31st of that year.
 - c) Adjacent land owners and lessees have the first option to salvage hay along municipal right-of-ways. Other persons wishing to salvage hay must first contact the adjacent landowner or lessee and then obtain the necessary permit.
 - d) The right-of-way must be left in a neat appearance by the person salvaging the hay.
 - e) All bales of hay must be off the traveled portion of the road.
 - f) All bales must be removed by the permit holder by August 31st of that year.
 - g) In order to minimize hazards to motorists, any bales not removed by August 31st of that year may be removed by the municipality and the cost of removal shall be charged to the permit holder/person salvaging hay.
 - h) The Council reserves the privilege and right for its members, employees and/or agents to enter upon said right-of-way for the maintenance, re-construction and spraying of the said right-of-way or for other such purposes as may be deemed necessary, and at no compensation or reimbursement to the party salvaging the hay therefrom.
 - i) The municipality assumes no liability for laborers, machinery or bales relating to the salvage of hay operations.
 - j) No person shall cut hay on any portion of a right-of-way located in the municipality during the period from one-half hour after sunset until one-half hour before sunrise.
 - k) No person shall cut hay on any portion of a right-of-way located in the municipality so as to obstruct the traveled portion of the right-of-way.
 - 1) The Administrator shall advertise the need for permits by June 15th of each year.
