

BYLAW NO. 3/86

A BYLAW TO REGULATE THE USE OF THE MUNICIPAL WATER SUPPLY.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of North Qu'Appelle No. 187, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. No person shall:
 - (a) fill a chemical spray apparatus;
 - (b) fill a water tank on a truck or similar transport vehicle that contains full or used chemical containers, pumps, hoses or other equipment used in conjunction with a chemical sprayer;
 - (c) park a chemical spray apparatus;
 - (d) park a truck or similar transport vehicle that contains full or used chemical containers, pump, hoses, or other equipment used in conjunction with a chemical sprayer;at or within one hundred (100) metres of the municipal well located adjacent to the road in the northwest corner of Block 11B, Plan CD 1379, Fort Qu'Appelle Reserve.
2. Any person found guilty of an infraction of any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalties imposed by the general penalty bylaw of the municipality.
