

The Rural Municipality of North Qu'Appelle No. 187

Bylaw No. 96-10

A BYLAW TO PROHIBIT THE DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS PURSUANT TO SECTION 215(1)(d) OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY ACT, 1989

The Council of the Rural Municipality of North Qu'Appelle No. 187, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. Subject to sections 2 and 3 hereof, no person shall discharge a firearm, air gun or spring gun within this municipality.
2. This bylaw shall not apply where a firearm, air gun or spring gun is discharged outside a hamlet:
 - (a) by any person on land with the consent of the occupant of such land;
 - (b) by any person permitted to hunt under The Migratory Birds Convention Act (Canada) or the regulations thereunder; or
 - (c) during the open season where the person is the holder of a licence to hunt big game or game birds issued to him under The Wildlife Act.
3. The Council may, after contacting all adjacent landowners, authorize the administrator to issue to a recognized gun club or similar organization a permit in writing entitling it to operate for the purpose of supervised target practice or similar activities.
4. Any person found guilty of an infraction of any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalties provided in the General Penalty Bylaw of this municipality.
5. Bylaw No. 71-5 is hereby repealed.
