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RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF NORTH QU'APPELLE NO. 187 BYLAW NO 2017-08 A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH PROPERTY TAX INCENTIVES AND PENALTIES

The Council of the Rural Municipality of North Qu'Appelle No. 187 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. Due Date

Property and other taxes imposed by the Rural Municipality of North Qu'Appelle No. 187 are deemed to be imposed on the first day of January in each year and shall be due on 31st day of December of the year in which they are levied.

2. Penalty on Arrears of Taxes

- a) Taxes which remain unpaid after the 31st day of December of the year in which they are levied shall be subject to a penalty.
- b) The method of calculating the penalty shall be:
 - a simple rate of 1% per month, added on the first day of each month applied to the total taxes and penalties that remain unpaid at the end of the month preceding the month in which the penalty is being applied.
- c) The penalty charges are to be added to and shall form part of the tax roll.

DISCRETIONARY PROVISION

3. Incentive Program - Prompt Payment

- a) Discounts shall be allowed from the time the notice of the levy is sent until October 31, to encourage prompt payment of:
 - i) the current year's taxes on property;
 - ii) the current year's special taxes;
- b) Payments of current taxes received:
 - i) from the time the notice of the levy is sent until the end of August shall be eligible for a discount of 10% of the amount paid;
 - ii) during the month of September shall be eligible for a discount of 5% of the amount paid;
 - iii) during the month of October shall be eligible for a discount of 4% of the amount paid; and
 - iv) during the month of November and December shall be eligible for a discount of 0% of the amount paid.

DISCRETIONARY PROVISION

4. Incentive Program - Prepayments

- a) Between the months of September and July, discounts shall be allowed with respect to the prepayment of:
 - i) the next year's taxes on property;
 - ii) the next year's special taxes;
- b) The rate of discount relative to prepayment of taxes shall be a constant discount of 10%.

5. <u>Repeal Previous Incentive and/or Penalty Programs</u> Bylaws #08-01 are hereby repealed.

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Coming Into Force
 This bylaw shall come into force on July 25, 2017
