TUESDAY, JULY 10, 2018

- New Degelman mower has issues with hydraulic hoses. They are not crimped properly and are leaking. Have contacted Dionco Sales and Services in Yorkton and they will come to repair.
- Still need quotes for cutting trees on the Mackie and Pasqua Lake Roads.
- Shoulder pulling on the Wide Awake Road is progressing well. The Land Fill Road also needs shoulder work.
- The asphalt pile was put up this weekend. Approximately 1,000 yards.
- Kinsley Place, Margaret Street, Qu'Appelle Park are needing to be prepped for asphalt.
- Have received all positive comments on the Dust Control applied to Qu'Appelle Estates, Groome's Vista and farm yard sites.
- Walkington Concrete, Fort Qu'Appelle was not happy with the email that was sent to them regarding the heavy haul route. They advised that they do not overload, they do not speed and only haul when conditions are good. Also commented that the Lebreton Hill is hard on their trucks. My response was that their trucks were hard on our roads. They are asking Council to consider allowing them haul on the Invercauld Road again.

On July 3, Nicole, Sharron Pope, Larry Bedel and myself meet to discuss the improved property numbers for Pasqua Lake, Taylor Beach and the RM.

The concern Pasqua Lake has is that the RM improved property numbers dropped by 14 from 2017 to 2018, which they felt was excessive. The process of how these numbers are arrived at was explained to Mr Bedel. It was also pointed out that the 2017 numbers were from the 2013 assessment and the 2018 numbers are from the 2017 assessment. Therefore it is a change in numbers over a four year period.

Telephone Conversation: Advisory Services – Judy Kanak - July 5, 2018

I had emailed Judy on Wednesday regarding concerns for the PL Internet proposal and mail-in ballot, with the following concerns and attached a copy of the Pasqua Lake Community Internet Project sheet (attached) that was mailed with the ballots to improved property owners only:

"Good Morning Judy,

attached is copy of an informational letter regarding the Organized Hamlet of Pasqua Lake (within RM 187) that was sent out with a mail-out ballot to all property owners with improvements, which is just a simple yes or no ballot. The deadline for ballots is July 16, 2018 at 4:30 pm, so if the majority is "yes", then the project will proceed. I just have questions regarding this process:

- 1. The RM 187 Councillor involved with this project stated that the cost of the internet installation can be added to the 2018 tax levy as a "special tax" and stated he had spoken with Advisory Services. If this is so, should RM 187 have a bylaw and public notice?*
- 2. If there cannot be a special tax added to these improved properties, can the property owners be invoiced, like custom work? If yes, and the invoice is not paid by December 31, 2018, can the unpaid amount be added to their taxes?*

Judy contacted me by telephone on Thursday morning, July 5, 2018 at 8:52 regarding the email I had sent her:

1. Special Tax & Custom Work Invoice
 - a. Special Tax – cannot be used this year, as the project needs to be started and completed in the same fiscal year, January 1 to December 31, levy the tax and collect in the same year. According to the information sheet the project is to start October 23, 2018 and completed in the spring of 2019.
 - b. Special Tax – requires a bylaw and public notice with proper procedures and advertising.
 - c. Special Tax – needs to have public hearing, property owners have to be given the opportunity to voice their concerns.
 - d. Special Tax – is like every other tax and it CANNOT be stated that it must be paid by an earlier date.
 - e. Special Tax – Council can decide if there would be a discount on that special tax, and if not paid that tax enforcement would apply.
 - f. **Advisory had concerns that this proposed levy would only be going onto improved properties, as the internet is still an improvement on an empty lot and would increase the value; that it is a fair way to recoup the costs. Council must look ahead, not just the now.**
 - g. Mail-in ballots – All elections must follow proper procedure and advertising. As this mail-in ballot did not, it is okay for this to be considered an "informal survey" or "referendum".
 - h. Invoice – Custom Work – the internet proposal cannot be invoiced out like Custom Work. The only way to have the fee invoiced out would be to have 100% of the property owners agree and cannot be added to the taxes if unpaid.
 - i. For Custom Work to be added to taxes if unpaid, the property owner must have signed a Custom Work request form.

OTHER OPTIONS:

1. Local Improvement Tax Act
 - a. must go through the Saskatchewan Municipal Board (SMB) process.
 - b. SMB will advise what is considered a local improvement.
 - c. Local Improvement Tax Act – Clause "Any other work or service". SMB to decide if this fall under this clause.
 - d. Will still require public notice, public hearing and bylaw.
 - e. Advisory Services – Judy Kanak – does not lean toward this, it is a lengthy process.
2. Municipalities Act – "Additional Service Area" (ASA)
 - a. ASA – can have "specific area" and can be in any area of the RM.
 - b. ASA – can include the OH of Pasqua Lake and GV & LE.
 - c. ASA - levy can be spread out over period of time, example – 2 years
 - d. ASA – goes through public notice and bylaw.
 - e. ASA – does not have to go through SMB
 - f. ASA – If this tax goes into arrears, Council can decide to waive penalty if chosen to go over period of time
 - g. Advisory Services – has guide on website for this process.
 - h. Advisory Services – still advises to have public hearing for property owners to voice their concerns.

A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH MILL RATE FACTORS

The Council of RM of North Qu'Appelle No. 187 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. This bylaw shall be known as the "Mill Rate Factor Bylaw"
- 2. The following mill rate factor(s) shall be applied to the uniform mill rate levied against all taxable property for municipal purposes not including the Organized Hamlets of Pasqua Lake or Taylor Beach,

<u>Classification</u>	<u>Factor</u>
a) Agricultural	1.14
b) Residential	0.95
c) Commercial & Industrial	1.14

- 3. This bylaw shall come into effect on July 10, 2018.
