Taylor Beach Hamlet Report to RM 187 Council Sept. 4 2019 Ron Palmer

- Erin Canham was assigned to look into the creek and water issues of Taylor Beach. and invited WSA to Taylor Beach.
- Rick Jasper and Adam Matchuk. from WSA, saw first hand the water issues on May 16, 2019. They met and inspected the delta and creek where it joins the lake.
- Bruce Olesen reported on this visit at the hamlet board meeting of Aug 11. "It was generally
 agreed that the channel is filling and will continue to fill with sediment as long as the creek is
 allowed to run freely. The representatives from SaskWater agreed that the removal of the
 beaver damn several years ago was a miss-step and that we should consider the addition of
 mechanisms to slow the water flow (as the beaver damn did)."
- Bruce Olesen has discussed our issues with the farmer that owns the land that the creek runs through. The farmer, John Brandt is supportive of our group to find a solution.
- I informed the hamlet board of the Flood Damage Reduction Program FDRP and also of the Pentland Report (2015)
- Motion by Brian H to apply for the Flood Damage Reduction Program
- Motion by Brian H to have Bruce talk to John Brandt about water slowing solutions and to obtain signed permission to perform the work required.
- Brian H made the preliminary application to WSA (Glen Merkley) on August 13, and listed himself as the main contact for FDRP
- On Sat Aug 17 there was a special hamlet meeting on Water, Garnet Spanier attended and
 there was much discussion on how to apply for FDRP, with the final analysis that we should
 consider putting in riffle dams where the beaver had them. After the meeting Garnet Spanier
 and I took a drive to an upstream point on the north leg of the creek and we could see six
 beaver dams from one vantage point. The beaver were back, building our riffle dams for us.
- I used Google Earth, and I could identify at least a dozen beaver dams, and discovered that
 we already have dams -- the Wide Awake grid crosses both the north and south leg at Schill's
 Coulee and Brandt's Coulee respectively. My first thought would be to severely restrict the
 bottom culvert and have the water back up to a new culvert to let the water through before it
 runs over the road. I now think that it would be better to use a vertical culvert, specifically
 designed for each detention pond.
- I phoned Glen Merkley at WSA; he assured me that our application was in, he put me down as a contact, and informed me that someone would be assigned to help us put our application together.
- Stephen Smulan was assigned by WSA to help us. He first contacted the RM office, and then
 directed to me. I phoned him and we agreed to meet ASAP and he is coming out to Taylor
 Beach today, Sept 4, to go over information, pictures, old reports, and to inspect the creek and

- sites first hand. We will use this to make up a report or proposal that we will present to the RM, the Hamlet Board, and especially WSA.
- I have a number of motions, following this report that will facilitate the FDRP application or proposal.
- Tomorrow, Thurs Sept 5, we have a volunteer group following the oiler to patch and seal Taylor St.
