SARM Division 1 Meeting Report

The SARM Division 1 meeting was held Wednesday June 8, 2022, in Kipling. Reeve Lee Carlson and Administrator Dawn Lugrin attended on behalf of RM#187.

The meeting included presentations form SARM Officials, President Ray Orb and Division 1 Director Bob Moulding, as well as Executive Director Jay Meyer. Many additional SARM Staff were present.

Three presentations were given to the few RM representatives.

The First presentation was from the Ministry of Government Relations, Building & Technical Standards Branch. This presentation included handouts and a power point presentation covering the new Building Codes in Saskatchewan, requirements for all municipalities to have a building bylaw, the roles 7 responsibilities within each party to a bylaw, and the updated definitions and rules around farm buildings.

The Second presentation was from SARM Employee, Alexander Udey on the Clearing the Path (CTP) Program. A reminder that this program only pays for incremental top up of costs related to the maintenance of a designated primary weight corridor in the CTP program. It uses a weighted funding formula based on many factors by Ministry of Highways, including traffic counts. If the traffic count is under 35 daily trucks, the RM is allotted a grant of \$1,000/km. If the count is 36 daily trucks or greater, the funding I increased to \$1,200/km. The program is currently accepting new applications for consideration of new CTP corridors.

The Third presentation was by Terrry Hoeving, SARM Employee for the Rural Integrated Roads for Growth (RIRG) Program. Terry began by explaining briefly the program and noting that funding opportunities for new capital project applications will be announced soon. Funding is from Ministry of Highways for this program. All applications for projects must include updated/current engineered designs & estimates as a requirement of the grant, with a scoring system across the province. No guarantee that an application will be approved. This presentation also discussed traffic counts — Highways is moving to a 3-year rotation instead of a 5-year rotation for counts- they are planning for that to start in 2023.

Presentations rounded out with a round table session where groups were given an allotted time with each presenter for open discussion & questions.

The meeting ended with an open session with SARM Directors. This was a very short session – questions on feral boars in southeast, update on lobby efforts for strychnine use for rodent control, question on changes for education programs and mentoring new rural administrators, and an update request for working with Administration Associations to attract and retain qualified administrators.

A BYLAW TO EXTEND THE TIME REQUIRED FOR THE COMPLETION OF THE 2021 FINANCIAL STATEMENT

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF NORTH QU'APPELLE NO. 187 BYLAW NO 2022-10 A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH PROPERTY TAX INCENTIVES AND PENALTIES

The Council of the Rural Municipality of North Qu'Appelle No. 187 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. Due Date

Property and other taxes imposed by the Rural Municipality of North Qu'Appelle No. 187 are deemed to be imposed on the first day of January in each year and shall be due on 31st day of December of the year in which they are levied.

2. Penalty on Arrears of Taxes

- a) Taxes which remain unpaid after the 31st day of December of the year in which they are levied shall be subject to a penalty.
- b) The method of calculating the penalty shall be:
 - i) a compound rate of 1.50% per month, added on the first day of each month applied to the total taxes and penalties that remain unpaid at the end of the month preceding the month in which the penalty is being applied.
- c) The penalty charges are to be added to and shall form part of the tax roll.

DISCRETIONARY PROVISION

- 3. Incentive Program Prompt Payment
 - a) Discounts shall be allowed from January 1 until August 31 annually, to encourage prompt payment of:
 - i) the current year's taxes on property;
 - ii) the current year's special taxes;
 - b) Payments of current taxes received:
 - i) from January 1st until August 31st shall be eligible for a discount of 5% of the amount paid;
 - ii) during the month of September, October, November and December shall be eligible for a discount of 0% of the amount paid.
- 4. Repeal Previous Incentive and/or Penalty Programs
 Bylaws #2019-07 is hereby repealed.

5. Coming into Force

This bylaw shall come into force on January 1, 2022.
