

No, there is no ice on the lake. Ice usually appears well into December. The level is down a bit to 478.29 m ASL. It will probably stay close to this level for the winter.

I returned from the SARM convention in Saskatoon yesterday. The high light of the convention is the voting on Resolutions. There were 26 resolutions. They are not binding or laws, but rather are lobby instruments that suggest what SARM members want. I will give a short condensed report of the more interesting resolutions.

- That creeks and streams that are basically dry should not be designated "fish bearing" Carried 95%
- That the border at Climax and Monchy return to 7 day operation. Carried 98%
- That there be more training seats for Licensed Practical Nurses Carried 99%
- That there be more recruitment and compensation for school bus operators. Carried 83%
- That the Building Bylaw be optional for RMs Lost 78%
- That if there is a tie vote in an RM, that the incumbent retain their seat. Carried 68%
- That truckers tarp their aggregate when on provincial highways. Carried 95%
- That there be an independent body to review Engineered Designs Carried 74%
- That the province fund money for Community Service Officers. Carried 67% This item was on the news with the RCMP asking why they should not just be funded more?
- That a pilot vehicle be necessary when towing large agricultural machinery. As is required for commercial equipment. Carried 51%
- That the province pay for beaver tails Carried 82%
- That the government reconsider the requirement for a 30% reduction in fertilizer. Carried 93%
- That an RM should have the option of having their own Stray Animal Bylaw instead of having to follow The Stray Animals Act. Carried 79%
- The resolution that Water Security Agency (WSA) be more strict in stopping farmers from draining wetlands and sloughs. This resolution was withdrawn before it could be voted on. Interesting.
