RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF NORTH QU'APPELLE NO. 187

Bylaw No. 2025-02

A BYLAW TO REGULATE THE DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS WITHIN THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF NORTH QU'APPELLE NO. 187

WHEREAS Section 8(1) of The Municipalities Act authorizes the Council of a municipality to pass bylaws deemed necessary for promoting the safety, health, and welfare of its inhabitants;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Rural Municipality of North Qu'Appelle No. 187 deems it necessary to regulate the discharge of firearms within the Municipality;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the Rural Municipality of North Qu'Appelle No. 187, incorporated in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts Bylaw No. 2025-02 as follows:

Title

1. This bylaw shall be referred to as the "Firearms Bylaw."

Purpose

2. This purpose of this bylaw is to regulate the discharge of firearms within the Municipality and appoint Nuisance Wildlife Officers to control nuisance animals.

Definitions

- 3. In this bylaw:
 - a) "Council" means the Council of the Rural Municipality of North Qu'Appelle No. 187.
 - b) "Firearm" means any firearm as defined under The Criminal Code of Canada.
 - c) "Officer" means a member of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police or a Bylaw Enforcement Officer appointed under Section 373 of The Municipalities Act.
 - d) "Owner" means the person who owns, leases, or legally controls a property.
 - e) "Person" includes any individual, firm, company, or partnership.
 - f) "Nuisance Wildlife Control Officer" refers to a person authorized to trap, hunt, and dispose of nuisance animals.
 - g) "Country Residential Subdivision" means any area within the Rural Municipality of North Qu'Appelle No. 187 designated as R1, R2, RR, RH, or SE under the Municipality's Zoning Bylaw or the Calling Lakes Planning District Plan.
 - h) "Commercial Subdivision" means any area within the Rural Municipality of North Qu'Appelle No. 187 designated as C under the Municipality's Zoning Bylaw or the Calling Lakes Planning District Plan.
 - i) "Municipality" means the Rural Municipality of North Qu'Appelle No. 187.

Regulations

- 4. In this bylaw:
 - a) No person shall discharge a firearm within a Country Residential Subdivision, Commercial Subdivision, or within 500 meters of such subdivisions.
 - b) In addition to Section 3(a), no person shall discharge a firearm within the Municipality, except:



- i) on land owned, leased, or rented by the person, or with the consent of the landowner or lessee;
- ii) during open hunting seasons, by a person holding a valid hunting license issued under The Wildlife Act;
- iii) when Council has issued a permit to a recognized gun club or similar organization.
- c) This bylaw does not apply to peace officers as defined under The Criminal Code of Canada.

Nuisance Wildlife Control

- 5. In this bylaw:
 - a) The Council may appoint a Nuisance Wildlife Control Officer to trap, hunt, and dispose of wildlife, as well as remove or destroy the den, nest, dam, or usual habitat of wildlife causing damage.
 - b) The appointment of a Nuisance Wildlife Control Officer shall be contingent upon:
 - i. Receipt of a criminal record check from the Royal Canadian Mounted Police;
 - ii. Provision of a valid Firearms License (Possession and Acquisition) from the appointee.
 - c) In accordance with The Wildlife Regulations, 1981, a Nuisance Wildlife Control Officer may capture or kill wildlife that is:
 - i. Wounded, diseased, or a danger to the public;
 - ii. Causing a public nuisance.
 - d) The Officer may also remove or destroy any wildlife habitat that is causing or is likely to cause damage to property.
 - e) Pursuant to Clause 13(3) of The Wildlife Regulations, 1981, a Nuisance Wildlife Control Officer may hunt certain wildlife within 500 meters of any building or structure without the consent of the property owner.
 - f) Pursuant to Clause 13(3.1) of The Wildlife Regulations, 1981, the Officer may hunt other wildlife within 500 meters of any building or structure, without the property owner's consent.

Voluntary Penalty

- 6. In this bylaw:
 - a) If an Officer believes a person has contravened any provision of this bylaw, they may issue a Bylaw Violation Notice with a fine ranging from \$100.00 to \$500.00.
 - b) The Bylaw Violation Notice may be served by regular mail or by leaving it at the person's last known address.
 - c) The notice shall specify the violation and the amount that may be paid to avoid prosecution.
 - d) Payment of the fine within 15 days from the issue date will prevent further prosecution related to the violation.
 - e) A person may still contest a violation and defend themselves against any charges related to the contravention of this bylaw.

Offences And Penalties

- 7. In this bylaw:
 - a) Any person who violates or fails to comply with any provision of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and may, upon summary conviction, be subject to a fine of up to \$2,000 for individuals or \$5,000 for corporations.
 - b) If an Officer has reasonable grounds to believe a person has committed an offence under this bylaw, the Officer may seize the firearm involved in the offence.
 - c) If a firearm is seized, the Officer must initiate proceedings within 30 clear days or return the firearm to the owner.
 - d) If the firearm's owner is under 16 years of age, the firearm will be returned to the parent or guardian.

e) If the firearm is seized and proceedings are initiated, the firearm will not be returned to the owner or guardian unless the court has adjudicated the case and found the defendant not guilty.

SEVERABILITY

8. If any provision or part of this bylaw is found to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions will remain in effect.

REPEALING BYLAWS

9. Bylaw No. 96-10 (to prohibit the discharge of firearms) passed on July 8, 1996, and Bylaw No. 16-03 (appointing a Wildlife Eradication Officer) passed on February 9, 2016, are hereby repealed.


